



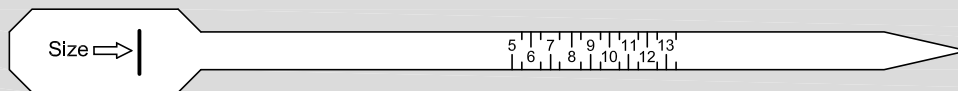

Helpful Hints

- For the most accurate measurement you may consider going to a jeweler to get your ring size.
- Measure finger in warm temperatures in the latter part of the day.
- For the first option, to insure the most accuracy have someone help you measure.
- For the second option you may consider first asking the recipients friend / mother if they know his ring size.
- *Due to the comfort fit and heavy weight of our rings, we strongly recommend ordering a half size smaller than your ring size. Whether you use one of our measurement options or you already know your ring size.

First Option

- Print and cut out our paper ring sizer.
- Cut a slit in the paper marked by the arrow.
- Slip the pointed end through the slit - numbers out.
- Place around your finger and pull the pointed end to make a snug fit.
- Make sure it is tight, but not too tight. Aim for a comfortable, snug fit.
- Read the size that appears at the slit.



Second Option

- Use this method if the finger cannot be measured (its a surprise gift).
- Find a ring that the intended recipient currently wears.
- Make sure the ring you use is worn on the finger you intend this ring to fit.
- Print this chart and place the ring on top of the circles below.
- The inside of the ring should line up against the outside of the circle.
